

Moderator's essentials for using Slido

Essential Tips

1. Introduce Slido

Share Wifi login details to make sure that everyone is connected to the internet. Navigate people to **slido.com** and have them enter the **#eventcode** to join the conversation.

2. Run a warm-up poll

Run a fun warm-up poll to give people a reason to join right from the start. Warm-up polls are a great way to ensure that people adopt Slido and use it for the rest of the event.

3. Use submitted questions

Acknowledge and ask at least a few of the top questions. Ignoring the questions might cause that people lose trust in the tool and might refrain from posting later on.

Pro Tips

1. Take a tablet on stage

If possible, take a tablet on stage with Slido open in the Admin view to have full control over the conversation.

2. Give the audience time for reflection

After the session, give people up to 1 minute to reflect on the key learnings. Then encourage them to send in their questions and upvote the questions from other participants.

3. Seed your questions during the session

Seed some of the questions that you prepared for the session in order to stir up the conversation as well as to let people decide which topics they're most interested to discuss.
